Year C (Psalter Week 4)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Todays readings are about Light! Candlemas (the official end of the Christmas season) was when candles were blessed for use in Church and in people's private prayer spaces. Jesus Christ is the light come into the world. He calls us to share in His mission to let His light shine out to all people in our world today. He was born as one of us and, because He has Himself been through temptation, He is able to help us when we are tempted. Jesus was rejected by many in His day yet, through His Death and Resurrection, He took away the power of evil.
