Welcome to St Patrick's Church. In today's famous Gospel story, we learn how Jesus takes away our shame if only we will return to the Father; confessing our weakness and waywardness. In Christ we are a new creation. He condemns sin but shows compassion and forgiveness to sinners. No one is perfect, we can only hoped to be saved by our perfect God.

First Reading: Isaiah 43:16-21 — Behold, I am doing a new thing and I will give drink to my chosen people

Responsorial Psalm: What great deeds the LORD ihas worked for us! Indeed, we were glad. (Psalm 126)
